### Education for Ministry Registration

Looking for a way to deepen your understanding of the Christian faith and to enhance the connection between what you believe and how you live your daily life? The Education for Ministry program combines independent study and weekly small group discussions to bring a basic grounding of theological education to Christian laypeople. EFM explores the content and origins of the Bible, follows Church history from its earliest days, and examines issues in Judeo-Christian theology. Guided theological reflections help to connect our faith understanding with Scripture and Christian tradition, and translate this into the cultural context of today. Sessions run from September to May/June. There are three groups currently meeting in Calgary. An online EFM course is also available. Registration is now open for the 2018/2019 session.
